

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

Our workforce development model affirms and supports:

- Exposure to aerospace careers can help initiate an individual's desire to pursue a career in the Aerospace industry.
- Aerospace careers require average to above average specialized skills and preparation, which necessitates economic, academic, social, and career support resources.
- Mentoring programs have a net positive impact on personal attitudes, motivation, behaviors, relationships, health, and career outcomes.

To move our mission forward, we will focus on:

- **Building Awareness**: We activate a network of over 2500 aerospace professionals to participate in school visits on a national level. We inform students about aerospace career tracks, and more importantly illustrate successful pathways.
- Preparing for Success: We've built several programs intended to address each
 learning phase from Elementary through College and beyond, to provide exposure to
 aerospace concepts, opportunities to build skills, and connect with mentors to help
 guide the way.
- Advocacy: We work hard to form relationships with industry partners to ensure our
 voice is heard on behalf of our members and the communities we serve. Through our

- Aerospace Professionals In Schools (APIS): Through in-person and virtual classroom visits,
 APIS introduces youth to the limitless opportunities available in aerospace and aviation
 beginning at an early age.
- Aerospace Education Academy (ACE): OBAP's Aerospace Career Education (ACE) Academy
 provides middle and high school youth with exposure to opportunities in aerospace through
 week-long summer academies. Endorsed by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA),
 OBAP has played a leading role in establishing ACE Academies nationwide to introduce,
 educate and guide diverse students towards careers in aerospace.
- Explore Aerospace: OBAP's newest program gives students the opportunity to deepen their knowledge of aviation and aerospace through a hands-on STEM-based curriculum from the comfort of home. Over the course of 12 weeks, students will learn from industry professionals, about principles of flight, aerodynamics, aerospace careers, meet guest speakers, go on virtual tours and so much more!
- **Girls LAUNCH:** Girls LAUNCH provides girls and women of all ages with interactive experiences and intimate conversations with female aerospace professionals to boost interest in the unlimited opportunities in aerospace.
- **Solo Flight Academy**: The OBAP Solo Flight Academy (SFA) is a two-week submersion in aviation training designed to excite and deepen exposure to opportunities in aviation, culminating in an unforgettable solo flight experience.
- Scholarships: Scholarships, made available through partnerships with key carriers and aerospace-related businesses, allow award recipients to advance or pursue diverse aerospace-related careers
- Luke Weathers Flight Academy: In 2018, OBAP launched the Lt. Col. Luke Weathers Jr. Flight
 Academy (LWFA) in Memphis, Tennessee. The Academy offers FAR 141 and 61 Flight training,
 UAV Pilot training, military rotor fixed-wing transition, Air Force candidate flight training,
 mentoring, and more.

APIS introduces youth to the limitless opportunities available through careers in aerospace and aviation beginning at an early age. APIS curriculum piques the interest of children, ages 6 - 10, through elementary science clubs and career days. Middle school-aged youth receive broader education and more in-depth exposure through career fairs, and community events.

APIS programs are also presented virtually, offering the opportunity to reach youth around the world.

APIS prepares aspiring aerospace professionals for fruitful careers. Since 1992, the program has reached over 500,000 people, many of whom now hold positions as commercial pilots, aircraft maintenance and flight dispatchers, business managers, and more.



AEROSPACE CAREER EDUCATION ACADEMY

OBAP's Aerospace Career Education (ACE) Academy provides middle and high school youth with exposure to opportunities in aerospace through week-long summer academies.

Endorsed by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), OBAP has played a leading role in establishing ACE Academies nationwide to introduce, educate and guide diverse students towards careers in aerospace. In 1992, OBAP partnered with the FAA to support two ACE Academies reaching 41 students. In 2023, OBAP hosted 41 academies with over 1200 students in attendance.

OBAP's immersive ACE Academies are tailored to provide exposure to the history of aviation, fundamentals of aerodynamics, air traffic control procedures, aerospace technologies, and introductions to aerospace careers.

Now in 41 locations including Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands, with two terms in Memphis and Louisville, the program engages 1,100 students on an annual basis.

To date, OBAP's 30+ ACE Academies have engaged more than 30,000 youth, and in 2023, reached over 1000 of students nationwide.

OBAP SOLO FLIGHT ACADEMY



The OBAP Solo Flight Academy (SFA) is a two-week submersion in aviation training designed to excite and deepen exposure to opportunities in aviation, culminating in an unforgettable solo flight experience. Tailored and restricted to young adults ages 16 – 19, the academic curriculum establishes the foundation of a productive and successful career in aviation-related professions.

While enrolled in the academy, students will receive approximately 40 hours of cursory and condensed ground school detailing federal air regulations, basic meteorology, navigation, basic engine theory, aircraft performance, basic maneuvers, STEM core principles, and the Airman's Information Manual.

Upon successful completion of the ground school, students will receive at least 10 hours of flight time. Once Federal Aviation requirements are met, the student will be cleared to serve as a "sole manipulator" for their very first time.
